3 ways

to transfer prescriptions from Accredo to another pharmacy

Option 1

- The patient can ask their physician's office for a new prescription and take it to another pharmacy

Option 2

- First, the patient informs Accredo of their preferred pharmacy
- Next, Accredo transfers the prescription to that pharmacy and follows up with a phone call

Option 3

- The patient can ask their pharmacy to call Accredo for the prescription to be transferred
